RULING

1. I have before me an *ex parte* chamber summons dated 19/07/2021 seeking leave of the court to apply for judicial review. The relief to be sought in such proceedings is an order of *mandamus* to compel the Attorney-General to satisfy the decree in *Nanyuki CM ELC No 13 of 2019*.
