**RULING**

The application dated 26th September 2012 prays that the accused persons be released on bond. I did order a prebail report on their behalf. The same were filed in respect to each offender.

From the above reports they are all favourable and bail being now a constitutional guarantee albeit discretionary I do make the following orders:-

- 1) Each of the accused persons shall be released on a bond of Kshs. 1,500,000 with a surety of similar amount.**
- 2) They shall each attend court on a monthly basis till the case is determined.**
- 3) While on bond they shall not in anyway interfere with the witnesses or in anyway interfere with the hearing and determination of this case.**
