2. **THAT** the Appellant is married to a Kenyan.
3. **THAT** the Appellant’s PSV/TSV licence has not been renewed due to a system oversight on the side of the Respondent.
4. **THAT** the Appellant is a holder of a valid Work/Resident permit issued under the Kenyan Citizenship and Immigration Act 2011.
5. **THAT** the Transport Licensing Appeals Board hereby directs that the Appellant uses this order in place of his PSV/TSV licence until the Respondent streamlines its system and renews his PSV/TSV licence.
