Mr. Machira for the respondent is not opposing this application by Rajdip Housing Development Co. This application was filed in a record time of less than two working days, after the first appeal, being C.A. I think Mr. Machira is correct in seeking costs. It was not for his fault that the appeal in question was struck out. The applicant is seeking an indulgence. The applicant will pay costs of this application within the next 21 days, failing which execution may issue.
