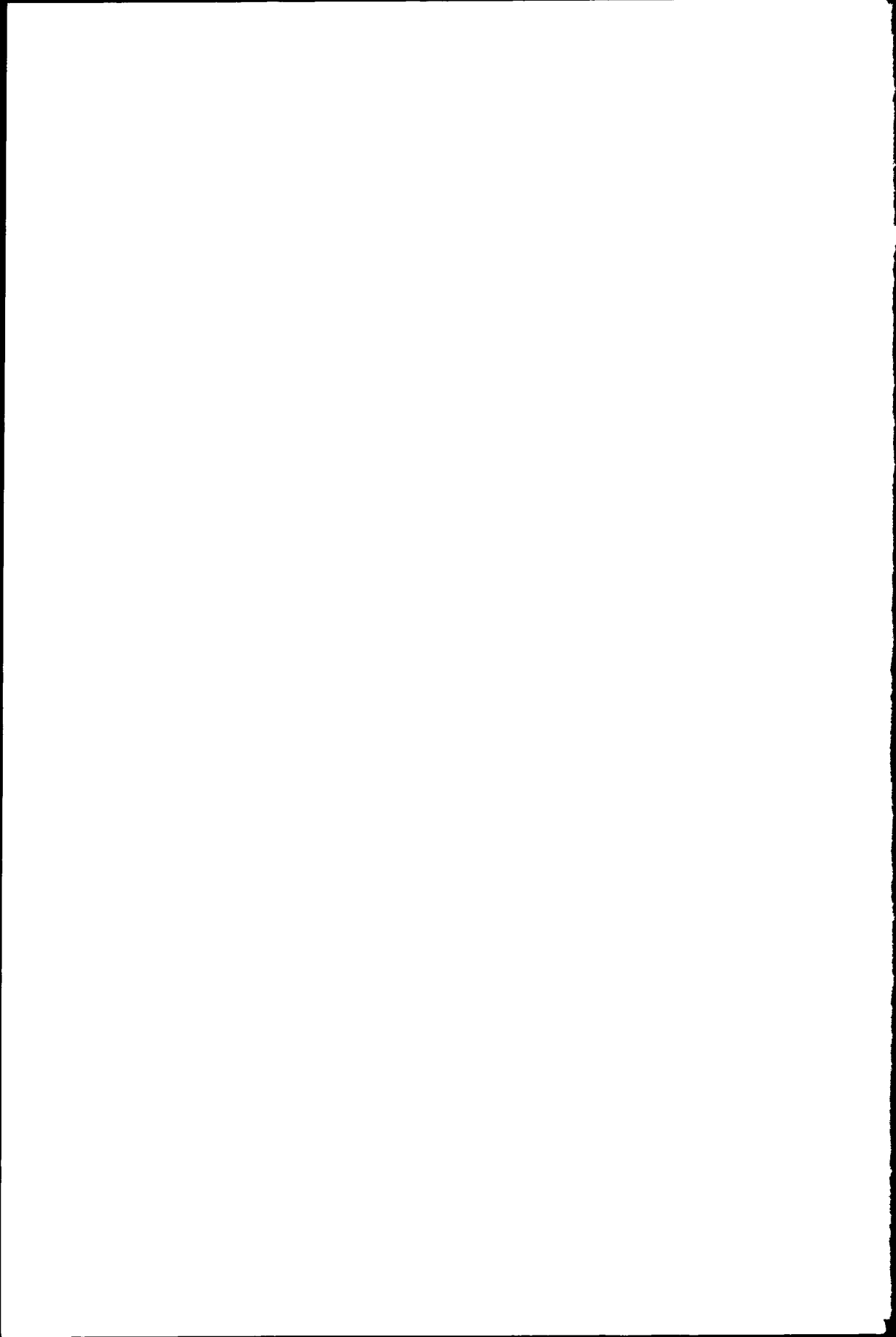

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THE UASIN GISHU COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2014

AN ACT of the Uasin Gishu County Assembly to provide for the various taxes, fees and charges for county services, and for other revenue raising measures by the County Government; and for the matters connected or incidental thereto.

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Uasin Gishu County Assembly as follows —

PART I — PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the Uasin Gishu County Finance Act, 2014 and shall come into operation on such a date as the County Executive Committee Member for Finance and Economic planning, with the concurrence of the Governor, may appoint, and different dates may be appointed for different provisions.

Short Title and Commencement.

PART II — TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES PAYABLE AND RATES APPLICABLE

2. (1) The taxes, fees and charges set out in the "New Charges" column of the schedules to this Act shall apply for the respective items listed in the "Items Description" column and at the rates set out therein.

Imposition, revision of the Taxes, Fees, etc of the County.

(2) Schedules 1 and 2 to this Act are part of this Act and shall be enforced as such.

(3) For greater certainty, the taxes, fees and charges applicable are payable to the Uasin Gishu County Government at the commencement of this Act, but which are not included in the schedule to this Act, shall continue to apply under the existing by-laws of the defunct Eldoret Municipal Council, County Council of Wareng, and Town Council of Burnt Forest, until such by-laws are specifically repealed or replaced by county legislation.

3. (1) All directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on or relating to financial management,

Directions, Resolutions, etc, under Local

including the collection and administration of taxes, fees and charges given or issued by the defunct Municipal council and subsisting or valid immediately before the cessation of the application of the Local Government Act (now repealed) shall be deemed to have been given, issued or made by or under the authority of the Uasin Gishu County Assembly until expiry, amendments or repeal of those directions, resolutions, orders and authorization on financial management and shall continue, with the necessary modifications, apply both to the payment and administration of the taxes, fees, charges and other levies under this Act.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to the specific respective amounts payable in respect of the taxes, fees, charges or other levies and, in that regard, the amount provided shall be as applicable shall be as provided for in the "New Charges" column in the Schedule.

4. (1) The County Executive Member in charge of Finance and Economic Planning may make regulations, not inconsistent with this Act respecting any matter that is necessary or convenient to be prescribed under this Act or for the carrying out or giving effect to this Act.

Powers of the relevant
County Executive
Committee Member.

(2) Regulations under sub section (1) shall not take effect unless approved by a resolution passed by the County Assembly.

(3) Regulations approved under sub section (2) shall take effect on the day after the date the County Assembly has approved them or, if a later date is specified in the regulations, on that date

5. If the County Assembly does not make a resolution either approving or rejecting any regulations within thirty (30) sitting days after submission to it for approval, the County Assembly shall be deemed to have approved those regulations on the 30th sitting day.
