

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 136

THE LABOUR RELATIONS ACT

(No. 14 of 2007)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 49 (1) of the Labour Relations Act, 2007, the Cabinet Secretary for Labour and Social Protection makes the following Order—

THE TRANSPORT WORKERS UNION KENYA (DEDUCTION OF AGENCY FEES) ORDER, 2021

1. This Order may be cited as the Transport Workers Union Kenya (Deduction of Agency Fees) Order, 2021. Citation.
2. The Scarce Commodities Limited and Fossil Fuel Limited shall— Deduction.
 - (a) deduct on a monthly basis the sum specified in the Schedule from the Basic Salary of each unionisable employee who is not a member of the Transport Workers Union Kenya, but is benefitting from terms and conditions of the Collective Bargaining Agreement entered between the Transport Workers Union Kenya and the Scarce Commodities Limited and Fossil Fuel Limited and registered by the Employment and Labour Relations Court of Kenya at Nairobi as RCA No. 201 of 2018 on 26th September, 2018;
 - (b) commence deductions within thirty days of receiving this Order;
 - (c) remit within ten days of the date of deductions, the total sums deducted under paragraph (a) by crossed cheque or electronic fund transfer payable to the Transport Workers Union's account number 0942830238 at Barclays Bank of Kenya Limited, Queensway House Branch, Nairobi;
 - (d) notify the trade union in writing within one month of payment; and
 - (e) make written returns to the Registrar of Trade Unions at P.O. Box 40326-00100, Nairobi, within one month of making all payments to the trade union.

SCHEDULE

A sum equal to 2.5% of employee's basic salary per month.
