LEGAL NOTICE NO. 112

THE TRAFFIC ACT
(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119 (1) of the Traffic Act, the Minister for Public Works and Housing makes the following Rules:—

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1999

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Rules, 1999.

2. The Traffic Rules are amended—

Sub. Leg.

(a) in rule 41 (2) by deleting all the items appearing after the words “according to the following scale” and inserting the following:

EXCESS AXLE LOAD WEIGHT AND EXCESS GROSS
VEHICLE WEIGHT

(b) in the Twelfth Schedule by—

(i) inserting the following new subparagraph immediately after paragraph 2 (1) (d)—

“(e) by way of a four axle group having four wheels on each axle32,000 kg.”

(ii) inserting the following new subparagraph immediately after paragraph 2 (2) (b)—

“(c) vehicle with four axles28,000 kg.”

(iii) inserting the following new subparagraph immediately after paragraph 2 (2) (f)—

“(h) vehicle and semi-trailer with a total of seven axles54,000 kg.”

(iv) inserting the following new subparagraph immediately after paragraph 2 (2) (i)—

“(l) vehicle and drawbar trailer with a total of seven axles54,000 kg.”

(v) re-numbering the existing subparagraphs “(c)”, “(d)”, “(e)”, “(f)”, “(g)”, “(h)”, and “(i)” as “(d)”, “(e)”, “(f)”, “(i)”, “(j)”, and “(k)”, respectively;

(vi) inserting the following new subparagraphs immediately after paragraph 2 (6)—

“(7) The maximum number of axles which may be fitted on any vehicle shall be seven provided that the rear-most axles shall be steering axles.

(8) No vehicle with a rigid body shall have more than three axles except for a vehicle with two steering axles and two rear axles”.

(vii) deleting the figure “18” appearing in paragraph 3 (e) (iii) and inserting the figure “22” in place thereof.
