

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 130

THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of powers conferred by section 119 of the Traffic Act, the Minister for Power and Communications hereby makes the following Rules:—

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1977

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Rules, 1977.

2. Rule 7 of the Traffic Rules is hereby amended—

(i) In paragraph (1) thereof by inserting after subparagraph (db) the following subparagraph—

“(dc) With effect from the first day of June, 1977, no person shall manufacture or sell reflective number plates without the written authority of the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.”

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 72 J of the Traffic Act, the Town Council of Kiambu hereby makes the following By-laws:—

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF KIAMBU (OMNIBUS STATION)  
BY-LAWS, 1977

Citation.

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Town Council of Kiambu (Omnibus Station) By-laws, 1977.

Interpretation.

2. In these By-laws, unless the context otherwise requires—

“council” means the Town Council of Kiambu.

“motor omnibus” means a public service vehicle having seating accommodation for more than seven passengers exclusive of the driver, and includes any motor-car, having seating accommodation for not more than ten passengers exclusive of the driver, which is used to carry passengers for hire or reward, whether or not such vehicle is licensed to be a public service vehicle.

“omnibus station” means the area of land provided by the council under by-law 3;

“owner” means the person in whose name a motor omnibus is registered under Part II of the Act, and, in relation to a motor omnibus which is the subject of a hire-purchase agreement or hiring agreement, includes the person in possession of the vehicle under that agreement.
