

- (k) in paragraph 3 of the Fourth Schedule in the first column under "crop"—
- (i) by inserting the words "ley pastures"; and
 - (ii) by inserting the words "important pasture weeds" in the second column under "weed".
- (l) in the Fifth Schedule by deleting the word "imposed" appearing at the footnote thereto and inserting the word "imported";
- (m) in the Sixth Schedule (contd.)—
- (i) in Form SR 7 by deleting the words "Notes—This order does not revoke the movement permit of scheduled crops obtainable from N.C.P.B. or K.G.G.C.U." appearing at the footnote thereto;
 - (ii) in the second column of Form SR 10B by deleting the words "As stated by seed inspector" and inserting the words "As stated by the sender";
 - (iii) in Form SR 11 by deleting the words "in tact" appearing after the words ".....lot/lots of seed" and inserting the word "intact";
 - (iv) in the Form marked "FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY" by deleting the fullstop at the end of the footnote thereto and the words "Ministry of Supplies and Marketing" and inserting the words "the Supplier or Merchant shall fulfil the requirements of the Ministry of Trade regarding the importation of seeds".

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 152

THE SEEDS AND PLANT VARIETIES ACT

(Cap. 326)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 18 of the Seeds and Plant Varieties Act, the Minister for Agriculture, makes the following Rules:—

THE SEEDS AND PLANT VARIETIES (AMENDMENT
TO THE FOURTH SCHEDULE) RULES, 1998

1. These Rules may be cited as the Seeds and Plant Varieties (Amendment to the Fourth Schedule) Rules, 1998.
2. The Fourth Schedule to the Act is amended in Part II—
 - (a) by deleting subparagraph (I) (b) of subrule (1);
 - (b) in rule 1 subparagraph (1) (d) of rule 1:
 - (i) by deleting the word "must" appearing in the sixth line and inserting the word "may".

(ii) by deleting the fullstop at the end of subparagraph (1) (d) and inserting the words, "but the variety must be new and distinct or different in some aspects of colour, content, resistance or yield potential, provided the indication is given as to where the variety has performed well to discourage the marketing of a variety outside its agro-ecological zone".

(c) in rule 2 subparagraph (2) of rule 2 by deleting the proviso thereof and inserting the following new proviso:

"Provided that the restriction imposed by this subparagraph shall not apply to sales or offers for sale made outside Kenya during the period of six years in the case of trees and vines, and four years in the case of others ending with the date of the application".

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 153

THE REGULATION OF WAGES AND CONDITIONS OF
EMPLOYMENT ACT

(Cap. 229)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 11 (3) of the Regulation of Wages and Conditions of Employment Act, the Minister for Labour makes the following Order;

THE REGULATION OF WAGES (BUILDING AND
CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY) ORDER, 1998

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Wages (Building and Construction Industry) Order, 1998.

Citation.

2. This Order shall apply to all persons (other than managerial and executive staff) employed in an undertaking which consists in the carrying on, for gain, of one or more of the following activities—

Application.

(a) the construction, structural alteration, maintenance or repair of any building, the demolition of any building and the preparation for, and laying the foundation of, any intended building; or

(b) the construction of any railway line or siding, and the construction, structural alteration or repair or the demolition of any airfield, dock harbour, wharf, quay, pier, inland navigation works, road tunnel, bridge, viaduct, waterworks, dam, reservoir, pipeline, aqueduct, sewer, sewage works or lattice work structure designed solely for the support of electricity lines.

3. The basic wage to be paid to any employee shall not be less favourable than that specified, in relation to category of employee and to the area of employment, in the First Schedule:

Basic
minimum
wage.

Provided that—

(a) an employee whose present daily or monthly wage is above that specified in the Regulation of Wages (Building and Construction
