LEGAL NOTICE No. 179

THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Traffic Act, the Vice-President and Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Rules—

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1972

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Rules, 1972.

2. With effect from 1st January, 1973, the Traffic Rules shall be amended by the revocation of rule 26 and the substitution therefor of the following—

Exhaust
systems.

26. Every motor vehicle propelled by an internal combustion engine or a compression ignition engine shall be so constructed and maintained that the exhaust gases from the engine cannot escape into the atmosphere—

(a) without first passing through a silencer, expansion chamber or other contrivance suitable and sufficient for reducing as far as may be reasonable the noise which would otherwise be caused by the escape of such gases; and

(b) except in the case of a vehicle constructed for the bulk carriage of inflammable liquid, otherwise than directly backwards from a point to the rear of the rearmost axle of the vehicle.

3. Paragraph (1) of rule 27 of the Traffic Rules is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "avoidable".
