

LEGAL NOTICE No. 180

THE EDUCATION ACT  
(Cap. 211)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 21 of the Education Act upon the Minister for Education, and in pursuance of a direction\* given under section 37 of the Interpretation and General Provisions Act, the Minister for Health and Housing hereby makes the following Order:—

THE EDUCATION (HOSPITAL HILL SCHOOL GOVERNORS)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1965

1. This Order may be cited as the Education (Hospital Hill School Governors) (Amendment) Order, 1965.

2. Paragraph 2 of the Education (Hospital Hill School Governors) Order, hereinafter referred to as the principal Order is amended by substituting for the words "situate at Hospital Hill in the Municipality of Nairobi" which appears in the definition of "the School", the words "situate at Parklands in the Nairobi Area".

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3. Paragraph 3 of the principal Order is amended—

(a) by substituting for subparagraph (1) thereof, the following new subparagraphs:—

(1) There is hereby established a Board of Governors of the Hospital Hill School, to be known as the Hospital Hill School Board of Governors, which is hereby declared to be a body corporate.

(2) The Board shall consist of not more than nine persons appointed by the Minister.

(b) by renumbering subparagraph (2) thereof as subparagraph (3) thereof.

(c) by deleting subparagraph (3) thereof.

4. The principal Order is amended by deleting paragraph 4 thereof.

5. Paragraph 5 of the principal Order is amended by deleting the word "unofficial" which appears therein.

6. Paragraph 6 of the principal Order is amended by substituting for the words "an unofficial" which appear therein, the word "a".

7. The principal Order is amended by substituting for paragraph 7A thereof, a new paragraph as follows—

7A. No Governor shall be subject to any personal liability in respect of any matter or thing done or omitted or any contract entered into by or on behalf of the Board.

8. Paragraph 8 of the principal Order is amended—

- (a) by deleting the word “unofficial” which appears in subparagraph (1) thereof;
- (b) by substituting for the words “An unofficial” which appear in subparagraph (2) (c) thereof, the word “A”;
- (c) by deleting the word “unofficial” which appears in subparagraph (3) thereof;
- (d) by deleting the word “unofficial” where it appears for the first time in subparagraph (4) thereof; and
- (e) by substituting for the words “an unofficial” which appears in subparagraph (4) thereof, the word “a”.

9. Paragraph 9 of the principal Order is amended—

- (a) by substituting for the words “four Governors” which appear in subparagraph (3) thereof, the words “one half of the membership of the Board”;
- (b) by substituting for the words “an official” which appear in subparagraph (3) thereof, the word “a”; and
- (c) by inserting at the end thereof, a new subparagraph as follows—

(9) The Minister may appoint a representative or representatives, who shall have the right to attend meetings of the Board and to speak thereat but shall not have the right to vote.

10. Paragraph 10 of the principal Order is amended by substituting for subparagraph (a) thereof, a new subparagraph as follows—

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- (a) in accordance with the Act and with the Teachers Service Act, with rules and regulations made thereunder and with this Order.

11. Paragraph 11 of the principal Order is amended—

- (a) by substituting for subparagraph (c) thereof, a new subparagraph as follows—
  - (c) all persons engaged by the Board on the staff of the School shall serve under a written contract of service with the Board;
- (b) by substituting for subparagraph (g) thereof, a new subparagraph as follows—

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- (g) subject to the provisions of the Teachers Service Act and this Order, teaching and non-teaching staff shall be employed in accordance with terms and conditions of service approved by the Chief Education Officer.

12. Paragraph 14 of the principal Order is amended by substituting for the words “any case of expulsion or exclusion from the School shall require the confirmation of the Board, and shall at once be reported to the Chief Education Officer” which appear in subparagraph (3) thereof, the words “no pupil shall be removed from the School except after prior consultation with the Chief Education Officer”.

13. Paragraph 16 of the principal Order is amended by substituting for subparagraphs (1), (2) and (3) thereof, two new subparagraphs as follows—

16. (1) All such immovable property, shares, funds and securities as may from time to time become the property of the Board shall be in the name of the Board of Governors of the Hospital Hill School and shall be dealt with in such manner as the Board may from time to time determine, subject to the conditions upon which any grants are made from public funds for capital or recurrent purposes and the conditions upon which any endowment bequest or donation is made for any purpose connected with the school.

(2) The common seal of the Board shall be in the custody of the secretary of the Board and shall be signified by the Chairman of the Board or such other Governor as the Board may by resolution appoint and by any one other Governor.

14. The principal Order is amended by deleting paragraphs 20, 22, 24 and 24A thereof.

15. Paragraph 26 of the principal Order is amended by substituting for the words "by the Government or the Colonial Development and Welfare Fund" which appear therein, the words "out of public funds".

### THE HIDE AND SKIN TRADE ACT

(Cap. 359)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 21 of the Hide and Skin Trade Act, the Minister for Agriculture and Animal Husbandry hereby makes the following Rules:—

#### THE HIDE AND SKIN TRADE (IMPOSITION OF CESS) (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) RULES, 1965

1. These Rules may be cited as the Hide and Skin Trade (Imposition of Cess) (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules, 1965, and shall come into operation on 1st July 1965.

2. Rule 3 of the Hide and Skin Trade (Imposition of Cess) Rules is amended by substituting for the figure "20.00", which appears in paragraph (c) thereof and which relates to sheepskins, the figure "25.00".
