**THE TRANSFER AND DELEGATION OF POWERS
ORDINANCE, 1955**

(No. 31 of 1955)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Transfer and Delegation of Powers Ordinance, 1955, the Governor, with the approval of the Legislative Council, has been pleased to make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Transfer of Powers (Minister for Local Government, Health and Housing) (No. 1) Order, 1956.

2. The exercise of the powers or the performance of the duties conferred upon or vested in the Governor by the provisions of the Ordinances specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby transferred to the Minister for Local Government, Health and Housing.
