

THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 199 of the Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport and Communications makes the following Rules:—

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) (No. 3) RULES, 1992

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) (No. 3) Rules, 1992.

2. The Traffic Rules are amended by deleting rule 7A (5) and inserting the following new Rule— Sub. Leg.

Authorization. 7A. (5) In the case of foreign commercial or public service vehicle in respect of which there is not in force an International Certificate or P.T.A. Carrier Licence the licensing officer may, on payment of the appropriate fee set out in the First Schedule, issue an authorization permit in the prescribed form valid for a period not exceeding thirty days; and on expiration of the authorization permit the owner shall apply for the registration and licensing of the vehicle in Kenya or shall remove it from or send it out of Kenya:

Provided that the Registrar may, on payment of the appropriate fee, issue a further authorization permit for a further period of fourteen days if the owner of the vehicle has not finalized arrangements for inspection of the vehicle or for removal of the vehicle from Kenya, or has not completed customs formalities.
