

LEGAL NOTICE No. 243

THE SOCIETIES ACT

(Cap. 108)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 53 of the Societies Act, the Attorney-General makes the following Rules:—

THE SOCIETIES (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1988

1. These Rules may be cited as the Societies (Amendment) Rules, 1988 and shall come into operation on the 17th June, 1988.

Sub. I.eg.

2. The Societies Rules are amended by repealing rule 18 and inserting the following—

18. The following fees shall be payable to the Registrar—

	<i>Sh.</i>
(a) on application for registration or exemption from registration as a society	100
(b) on a registered society furnishing an annual return under rule 12—	
(i) where the membership does not exceed 25 members	30
(ii) where the membership exceeds 25 members but does not exceed 100 members	50
(iii) where the membership exceeds 100 members but does not exceed 1,000 members	80
(iv) where the membership exceeds 1,000 members	200
(c) on a registered society applying for permission under section 20 of the Act to do any of the things for which permission is required under that section	50
(d) on a registered society giving notice of change of registered office or postal address	20
(e) on giving notice of any change of officers or of the title of any officer of a registered society	20
(f) for inspection of the register and any documents lodged with the registrar relating to any society for each society in respect of which inspection is made	5
(g) for a certified copy of or certified extract from any documents in the custody of the Registrar	50
(h) for issue of a fresh certificate under rule 12 (3)	10
(i) for official search in respect of society ...	20
(j) on dissolution of a society	80
