

(2) Where an employee who has held a non-pensionable office for a period of not less than seven years dies while in the employment of the council, his dependant shall be paid by the council a gratuity calculated on the basis which is specified in subrule (1).

LEGAL NOTICE No. 262

THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 118A of the Traffic Act, the City Council of Nairobi hereby makes the following By-laws:—

THE CITY OF NAIROBI (TAXI-CAB) (AMENDMENT) BY-LAWS, 1976

1. These By-laws may be cited as the City of Nairobi (Taxi-cab) (Amendment) By-laws, 1976.

L.N. 169/1963.

2. The City of Nairobi (Taxi-cab) By-laws, 1963, are hereby amended—

(a) by substituting for by-law 26 thereof the following new by-law—

“26. (1) The owner or driver of a taxi-cab shall be entitled to demand for the hire of the vehicle the fare prescribed in the Fifth Schedule to these By-laws, the rate or fare being calculated by distance unless the hirer expresses at the commencement of the hiring to engage by time.

(2) Where the hiring is by distance the owner or driver thereof shall not be entitled to demand a fare greater than that on the face of the taximeter, save for extra charges as laid down in the Fifth Schedule to these By-laws, which may not be recorded on the face of the taximeter.”; and

(b) by inserting immediately after the Fourth Schedule thereto the following new Schedule—

FIFTH SCHEDULE

(by-law 26)

MAXIMUM FARES

(i) <i>Distance</i>	<i>Sh. cts.</i>
If the distance does not exceed one kilometre, for the whole distance	5 00
If the distance exceeds one kilometre, for the first kilometre	3 20
For each subsequent kilometre at the rate of (per quarter kilometre or part thereof)	80

(ii) *Waiting time*

At the rate of Sh. 3 for each 15 minutes detained ...

(iii) *Extra charges*

Per journey for each article of luggage conveyed on a luggage rack outside the vehicle	3 00
For each passenger in excess of two	3 00
