## THE TRADE DISPUTES ACT

(Cap. 234)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 2 of the Trade Disputes (Levies and Subscriptions other than Trade Union Dues) Regulations, 1974, the Minister for Labour hereby makes the following Order:—

THE COLLECTION OF SUBSCRIPTIONS (KENYA UNION  
OF COMMERCIAL, FOOD AND ALLIED WORKERS)  
ORDER, 1977

1. This Order may be cited as the Collection of Subscriptions (Kenya Union of Commercial, Food and Allied Workers) Order, 1977.

2. The Kenya Union of Commercial, Food and Allied Workers is hereby authorized to collect subscriptions (other than trade union dues) from its members for the approved purpose of financing the purchase of a building to be used as an educational, re-creational, cum-holiday centre and office for the Union and its members.

3. Every employer who employs not less than ten members of the Union and upon whom a notice in writing shall have been served by the General Secretary of the Union pursuant to regulation 6 of the Trade Disputes (Levies and Subscriptions other than Trade Union Dues) Regulations, 1974, is hereby required to deduct from the wages of each of his employees who is named in such notice, and who in such notice acknowledges that he is a member of the Union, the sum of ten shillings in one month and to make payment of the total sum so collected into the Unions' Levy Account at Barclays Bank International, Mama Ngina Street Branch, P.O. Box 30011, Nairobi.

## THE BUILDING SOCIETIES ACT

(Cap. 489)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 77 (3) of the Building Societies Act, the Attorney-General hereby makes the following Regulations:—

THE BUILDING SOCIETIES (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS, 1977

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Building Societies (Amendment) Regulations, 1977.

Sub. Leg.

2. The Building Societies Regulations are hereby amended in regulation 5 (1) by the deletion of the expression "in excess of £15,000" and the substitution therefor of the expression "in excess of £25,000".

## THE ADVOCATES ACT

(Cap. 16)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 21 of the Advocates Act, the Council of Legal Education hereby makes the following Regulations:—

### THE ADVOCATES (ADMISSION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1977

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Advocates (Admission) (Amendment) Regulations, 1977.

Sub. Leg.

2. The Advocates (Admission) Regulations are hereby amended—

(a) in paragraph (2) of regulation 13—

(i) by the deletion of the figure "16" and the substitution therefor of the figure "15";

(ii) by the addition at the end of the following sentence— A candidate may lodge a late application to sit for any of these examinations with the Secretary of the Council not later than the 10th March, the 10th June and the 10th November respectively.

(b) in regulation 15 by the addition at the end of the following sentence—

An applicant lodging a late application in accordance with regulation 13 of these Regulations shall pay an additional late entry fee of thirty shillings in respect of each examination paper.
