## THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Traffic Act, the Vice-President and Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Rules:—

## THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) RULES, 1975

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules, 1975.

2. The Traffic Rules are hereby amended by the deletion of rule 30 and the substitution therefor of the following— Sub. Leg.

Windscreens and windows. 30. (1) Every motor vehicle shall be so designed, constructed and used that the driver controlling it has a full view of the road and traffic ahead.

(2) The windscreen and windows of every motor vehicle shall be kept free from the application of any material which has, or is capable of having, reflective properties.

(3) The windscreen of every motor vehicle shall be kept in such condition that the driver's view is not impeded.

## THE CUSTOMS TARIFF ACT

(Cap. 472)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Customs Tariff Act, the Minister for Finance and Planning hereby makes the following Order:—

## THE CUSTOMS TARIFF (REMISSION) (No. 2) ORDER, 1975

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Remission) (No. 2) Order, 1975, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1974, and, unless earlier revoked, shall expire on 30th June, 1975.

2. The whole of the fiscal entry, import duty and suspended fiscal entry payable on nylon twines imported or purchased prior to clearance through the Customs by or on behalf of Kenya Fishnet Industries Limited for the manufacture of fishnets is hereby remitted.
