

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 280

THE TREATY FOR EAST AFRICAN CO-OPERATION  
ACT 1967

(No. 31 of 1967)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Treaty for East African Co-operation Act 1967, the Attorney-General hereby makes the following Order:—

THE TREATY FOR EAST AFRICAN CO-OPERATION  
ORDER 1967

1. This Order may be cited as the Treaty for East African Co-operation Order 1967, and shall come into operation on the 1st December 1967. Citation and commencement.

2. Section 26 (2) of the Valuation for Rating Act is amended by inserting therein, immediately after the word "officer", the word "institution". Amendment of Cap. 266.

3. Section 117 (2) of the Stamp Duty Act is amended by replacing all the words after "Kenya" with the words "and to the Community". Amendment of Cap. 480.

4. Subject to section 20 of the Act and to the foregoing paragraphs of this Order— Amendment of written laws generally.

(a) every written law which contains the word "Organization" (meaning the East African Common Services Organization) or the words "East African Common Services Organization" is amended by replacing that word or those words, in each case, with the word "Community":

Provided that—

- (i) this section does not apply to Acts of the Community;
- (ii) this section does not amend the definition of "the Organization" contained in section (3) 1 of the Interpretation and General Provisions Act.

Cap. 2

(b) every written law which contains the word "Authority" (meaning the East African Common Services Authority) or the words "East African Common Services Authority" is amended by replacing the word "Authority" with the word "Community".
