## THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 118A of the Traffic Act and regulation 201 of the Local Government Regulations, 1963, the Municipal Council of Kisumu hereby makes the following By-laws:—

THE KISUMU MUNICIPALITY (TAXI-CAB) (AMENDMENT)  
BY-LAWS, 1969

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Kisumu Municipality (Taxi-cab) (Amendment) By-laws, 1969.

L.N. 133/1966.

2. The Kisumu Municipality (Taxi-cab) By-laws, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal By-laws), are amended by substituting for the definitions of "public service vehicle" and "taxi-cab" respectively which appear in by-law 2 thereof the following definitions—

"public service vehicle" means any motor vehicle which—

- (i) is licensed under these By-laws to carry passengers for hire or reward within the Municipality; or
- (ii) plies for hire or reward or is let out for hire or reward; or
- (iii) is carrying passengers for hire or reward;

"taxi-cab" means any public service vehicle constructed or adapted to carry not more than seven passengers, exclusive of the driver, which is registered by the Council to ply for hire or reward from any of the specified taxi ranks or other public place within the Municipality.

3. By-law 6 (1) of the principal By-laws is amended by inserting immediately after the words "subject to the provisions of by-laws 7 and 13 of these By-laws", the words "and after consultation with the Police as regards section 96 (3) (f) of the Act".

4. By-law 17 (1) of the principal By-laws is amended by inserting immediately at the end of subparagraph (i) thereof, new subparagraphs as follows—

(j) provide efficient fire extinguishers which shall be always maintained in perfect order and shall be carried in such a position as to be readily available for use at any time;

(k) provide first aid box with perfect medical equipment and medicines.

5. By-law 32 of the principal By-laws is amended by numbering it as subparagraph (1) thereof and inserting at the end thereof a new subparagraph as follows—

(2) offences under these By-laws shall be cognizable to the Police.

6. The principal By-laws are amended by inserting immediately after by-law 32 thereof a new by-law as follows—

33. These By-laws shall be deemed to apply in all cases in so far as they affect by-laws 463, 464 and 465 of the Kisumu Municipality (General) By-laws, 1954.
