

LEGAL NOTICE No. 36

THE STAMP DUTY ACT

(Cap. 480)

EXEMPTION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 106 of the Stamp Duty Act, the Minister for Finance directs that the instruments executed in respect of purchase and transfer of plot L.R. No. Block 82/401, situated in Sunrise Estate, Nairobi, from Charles Peter Njendu and Rose Jesang Njendu, both of P.O. Box 58622, Nairobi to Missionaries of Charity, P.O. Box 32778, Nairobi shall be exempt from the provisions of the Act.

LEGAL NOTICE No. 37

THE FOOD, DRUGS AND CHEMICAL SUBSTANCES ACT

(Cap. 254)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 28 of the Food, Drugs and Chemical Substances Act, the Minister for Health makes the following Regulations:—

THE FOOD, DRUGS AND CHEMICAL SUBSTANCES (FOOD LABELLING, ADDITIVES AND STANDARDS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1999

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Food, Drugs and Chemical Substances (Food Labelling, Additives and Standards) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999.

2. The Food, Drugs and Chemical Substances (Food Labelling, Additives and Standards) Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, are amended in paragraph (c) of regulation 42 by inserting the expression "green S (colour index number 44090, 1971)", after the expression "tartrazine (colour index number 19140, 1971)".

3. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 150 and inserting the following new Regulation—

"150 (1) Skimmed milk powder (skim milk powder, skimmed milk powder, dry skim milk, powdered skim milk, non-fat dry milk, dried skim milk) shall be the product obtained by the removal of water from skimmed milk.

(2) Dried skimmed milk powder with non-milk fat, skimmed milk powder shall be the product obtained by the removal of milk fat and water from milk and replacing it with (naming the appropriate designation of each fat or oil) vegetable fat or oil, retaining the appearance of skimmed milk powder.

(3) Each of the types of milk powder specified above—

(a) may contain stabilizers as prescribed in the Second Schedule;

- (b) shall have not less than 26 per cent vegetable fat or oil and not more than 5 per cent water;
- (c) shall be enriched with Vitamins A and D; and
- (d) shall include the following warning in the label:

“NOT FIT FOR INFANTS.”

4. The principal Regulations are amended in Part I of the First Schedule by adding the following new item immediately after item 204—
“205. Dried skimmed milk powder with non-milk fat.”

5. The principal Regulations are amended in Table III of the Second Schedule by inserting the expression “green S” immediately after the expression “4R” appearing in the first column of item 5.
