

(vii) one shall be nominated to represent the fishing industry from a panel of names submitted by the Regional Government Agent.

3. Paragraph 5 of the principal Order is amended by deleting the word "Area" and the word "Urban" which appear in subparagraphs 1 (a) and 1 (b) thereof respectively.

4. Paragraph 6 of the principal Order is amended by substituting for the words "Malindi Area County Division" which appear therein the words "Malindi County Division".

THE KENYA ORDER IN COUNCIL 1963

(L.N. 245 of 1963)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Kenya Order in Council 1963, the Governor hereby makes the following Regulations:—

THE KENYA (AMENDMENT OF LAWS) (FILMS AND STAGE PLAYS) REGULATIONS, 1963

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Kenya (Amendment of Laws) (Films and Stage Plays) Regulations, 1963, and shall come into operation on the commencement of the Ordinance.

2. In these Regulations, "the Ordinance" means the Films and Stage Plays Ordinance, 1962.

34 of 1962.

3. The Ordinance is amended by substituting for section 24 thereof a new section as follows—

24. For the purposes of this Part, the Minister may, by notice in the Gazette, appoint the City Council of Nairobi to be the licensing authority for the Nairobi Area, and a Regional Assembly of a Region may, by notice in the Regional Gazette, appoint a local authority or a Regional Government Agent to be the licensing authority for a specified area of this Region.

4. Section 28 of the Ordinance is amended by substituting for the word "Gazette" the words "Kenya Gazette or Regional Gazette, as the case may be,".

5. The Ordinance is amended by substituting for section 29 thereof a new section as follows—

29. Any person who is aggrieved by a decision of a licensing officer, licensing authority, stage plays licensing authority or the Board under this Ordinance may—

(a) in the case of a decision of a licensing authority appointed by a Regional Assembly, appeal to that Regional Assembly; and

(b) in any other case, appeal to the Minister;

and the Regional Assembly or the Minister, as the case may be, may, subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, confirm, vary or reverse the decision, and may give such directions in the matter as may be necessary and the decision of the Regional Assembly or the Minister shall be final and shall not be questioned in any court.

6. Section 30 of the Ordinance is amended by inserting immediately after the word "Minister", the words "or, where it is given or issued by a licensing authority appointed by a Regional Assembly, by the Regional Assembly,".

7. Section 35 (2) of the Ordinance is amended by inserting at the end of paragraphs (d), (e) and (f) thereof in each case the words "in the Nairobi Area".

8. The Ordinance is amended by inserting immediately after section 35 thereof a new section as follows—

Regional
Assembly
may make
Regulations.

35A. A Regional Assembly may make regulations—

(a) prescribing fees for theatre licences and cinema licences, and for that purpose licences may be divided into different classes and a different fee prescribed for each class;

(b) prescribing the procedure for appeals to a Regional Assembly under this Ordinance;

(c) prescribing the periods for which theatre licences and cinema licences shall be issued;

(d) prescribing the conditions to be observed in regard to the erection, duration and equipment of any theatre or cinema;

(e) prescribing the conditions to be observed in regard to securing the safety of theatres and cinemas from fire or other danger, or the safety and control of persons attending at theatres and cinemas.
