## THE LAND CONTROL ACT

(Cap. 302)

## EXEMPTION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Land Control Act, I, Jomo Kenyatta, President and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Kenya, hereby exempt the controlled transaction details of which are set out in the Schedule hereto from all the provisions of the Act.

## THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Traffic Act, the Vice-President and Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Rules:—

## THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1973 4

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Rules, 1974.

2. Rule 7 of the Traffic Rules is hereby amended—

(a) by the deletion of subparagraphs (da) and (db) of paragraph (1);

(b) by the deletion of paragraph (2) and the substitution therefor of the following—

(2) Any person who—

(a) uses on a road a motor vehicle or trailer the identification plates of which are not clearly visible or legible; or

Sub. Leg.

- (b) is the owner of a motor vehicle or trailer the identification plates of which are, by reason of damage thereto, illegible, or which contain any letter or number other than the identification marks assigned to the vehicle or trailer (or any other letter or number authorized by the Registrar), or which do not comply with the provisions of this rule, shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand shillings.
- (c) by the deletion of paragraphs (5) and (6).

LEGAL NOTICE No. 48

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS, 1963

(L.N. 256 of 1963)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulations 5 and 12 of the Local Government Regulations, 1963, the Minister for Local Government hereby makes the following Order:—

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MUNICIPALITY OF KITALE)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1974

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Municipality of Kitale (Amendment) Order, 1974.

2. Paragraph 2 of the Local Government (Municipality of Kitale) Order 1968, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) is hereby amended by substituting therefor the following new paragraph—

L.N. 233/1968.

3. The area set forth in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a municipality to be known as the Municipality of Kitale.

4. The principal Order is hereby amended by substituting for the word "Schedule" wherever it appears in paragraph 3 thereof the word "Second Schedule".

5. The principal Order is hereby amended by inserting immediately after paragraph 7 thereof the following new Schedule—

An area of land of approximately 85 square kilometres, situated approximately 26 kilometres east of Mount Elgon Forest in the Trans Nzoia District, Rift Valley Province, the boundaries of which are more particularly delineated, edged grey on Boundary Plan No. 541/13, which is signed and is deposited in the Survey Records Office, Survey of Kenya, Nairobi and a copy of which may be inspected at the office of the Town Clerk to the Municipal Council of Kitale.
