

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 75

THE NATIONAL TRANSPORT AND SAFETY AUTHORITY ACT

(No. 33 of 2012)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 54 of the National Transport and Safety Act, the Cabinet Secretary for Transport and Infrastructure in consultation with the Board makes the following Regulations:—

THE NATIONAL TRANSPORT AND SAFETY AUTHORITY
(OPERATION OF PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 2014

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Transport and Safety Authority (Operation of Public Service Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations, 2014. Citation.

2. The National Transport and Safety Authority (Operation of Public Service Vehicles) Regulation, 2014, in these Regulations referred to as the “Principal Regulations”, are amended by inserting the following new Regulation immediately after Regulation 7 (f)— L.N. 23 of 2014.

7 (f) (a) A person desirous of providing the cash light fare system service shall obtain a letter of no objection from the Central Bank of Kenya.

3. Regulation 7(f) (1) of the Principal Regulations, is amended by deleting the words “cashless fare system” and substituting therefor the words “cash light fare system by the use of a contactless integrated circuit card which conforms to the ISO IEC 14443 standard.”
