

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 84

THE SOCIETIES ACT

(Cap. 108)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 53 of the Societies Act, the Attorney-General makes the following Rules:—

THE SOCIETIES (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1997

1. These Rules may be cited as the Societies (Amendment) Rules, 1997 and shall come into operation on gazettelement.
2. Rule 18 of the Societies Rules is repealed and replaced by the following:

Rule 18: The following fees shall be payable to the Registrar:

	KSh.
(a) On application for registration or exemption from registration of a society	1,000
(b) On a registered society furnishing an annual return under Rule 12 of these Rules—	
(i) where the membership does not exceed 25 ..	100
(ii) where the membership exceeds 25 but does not exceed 100	150
(iii) where membership exceeds 100 but does not exceed 1000	200
(iv) where membership exceeds 1000	400
(c) On a registered society applying for permission under section 20 of the Act to do any of the things for which permission is required under that section ..	100
(d) On a registered society giving notice of change of registered office or postal address	100
(e) On giving notice of any change of officers or of the title of any officer of a registered society ..	100
(f) For inspection of the register and any document lodged with the Registrar relating to any society for each society in respect of which inspection is made	50
(g) For a certified extract from any documents in the custody of the Registrar—	
(i) for the first folio of 100 words or part thereof ..	50
(ii) for every subsequent folio of 100 words or part thereof	20
(h) For issue of a fresh certificate under rule 12 (3) of these Rules	100
(i) For official search in respect of a society	100

(j) On dissolution of a society 500

THE BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS ACT
(Cap. 111)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 22 (f) of the Books and Newspapers Act, the Attorney-General makes the following Rules:—

THE BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1997

1. These Rules may be cited as the Books and Newspapers (Amendment) Rules, 1997 and shall come into operation on gazettment.

2. Rule 10 of the Books and Newspapers Rules is repealed and replaced by the following:

Rule 10: The following fees shall be payable to the Registrar:

(a) For inspection of any entries in a register kept by the Registrar relating to any one book or newspaper	50
(b) For a certified copy of or extract from any entry in a register per folio of 72 words minimum fee per copy or extract KSh. 50	20
(c) For inspection of any one book or newspaper delivered to the registrar in accordance with the provisions of this Act	50
(d) For filing an initial or annual return in respect of a newspaper	300
(e) For filing a return of change of particulars of a newspaper	100
(f) For filing a return in respect of a book	200
(g) For filing a bond by a printer or publisher	1,000
