THE CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS ACT 1963
(No. 8 of 1963)

APPOINTED LOCAL AUTHORITY

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 58 (1) of the Children and Young Persons Act 1963 the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order:—

THE CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS (APPOINTED
LOCAL AUTHORITY) (No. 15) ORDER 1966

1. This Order may be cited as the Children and Young Persons (Appointed Local Authority) (No. 15) Order 1966.
2. The County Council of Kwale is hereby appointed to be an appointed local authority for the purposes of the Act.

LEGAL NOTICE No. 9

THE TRAFFIC ACT
(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Traffic Act, the Minister for Power and Communications hereby makes the following Rules:—

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) RULES 1966

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules 1966.

2. Rule 41 of the Traffic Rules (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules) is amended by substituting for paragraph (a) thereof the following paragraphs—

- (a) the maximum weight of any vehicle fitted with pneumatic tyres laden or unladen shall not exceed—

Provided that the maximum weights transmitted to the road by all wheels the centres of which can be included between two parallel vertical planes extending across the full width of the vehicle shall not exceed the permissible weights given in the Eleventh Schedule to these Rules;

- (aa) subject to the provisions of rules 18 and 19 of these Rules, the maximum weight of any vehicle fitted with solid tyres shall be 75 per cent of the maximum weight permitted in paragraph (a) of this rule;

(aaa) the maximum weight inclusive of all accessories of any vehicle fitted with crawler type tracks shall not exceed 36,000 lb.:

Provided that the weight transmitted to the road between two parallel planes extending across the full width of the vehicle shall not exceed the weights permitted for pneumatic-tyred vehicles determined from the Eleventh Schedule to these Rules.

3. The principal Rules are amended by inserting, immediately after the Tenth Schedule thereto, a Schedule as follows—
