**AN ACT TO AMEND THE EAST AFRICAN CUSTOMS
MANAGEMENT ACT, 1952**

Date of Commencement: 30th November, 1961

ENACTED by the East Africa High Commission with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly thereof as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the East African Customs Management (Amendment) Act, 1961, and shall be read and construed as one with the East African Customs Management Act, 1952.

Short title.

2. Section 136 of the East African Customs Management Act, 1952, is hereby amended by the addition of the following subsection—

Amendment of section 136 of the principal Act.

“(4) without prejudice to the powers of a police officer to arrest any person for an offence against this Act which is cognizable to the police under any enactment of any of the Territories, for the purposes of this section the expression “officer” includes a police officer.”
