

**THE INSURANCE (MOTOR VEHICLES THIRD PARTY RISKS) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1987**

**An Act of Parliament to amend the Insurance (Motor Vehicles Third Party Risks) Act**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Insurance (Motor Vehicles Third Party Risks) (Amendment) Act, 1987 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 15th November, 1986.

2. The Insurance (Motor Vehicles Third Party Risks) Act is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 9—

9A. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 5, where there is in existence in respect of any motor vehicle a valid certificate issued under any law in force in any country specified by the Minister by notice in the Gazette, no person using that motor vehicle on any road in Kenya shall be required to produce a policy of insurance or a security in respect of third party risks required under section 4.

(2) It shall be the duty of the person to whom the provision of this section apply to give such information as he may be required to give to, or on behalf of, the Commissioner of Police for the purpose of determining whether the vehicle was or was not being driven in contravention of section 4.
