

(2) Except as provided in paragraph (1) (a) (iii) or paragraph (1) (a) (iv) of this rule, all coffee produced by a planter shall be processed in that planter's pulping station, and all coffee produced by members of a co-operative society shall be processed in that Society's pulping station or stations:

Provided that a society committee may, at its discretion, decline to accept coffee for processing unless it is of the standard required and is delivered at the time and place directed:

Provided further that in the event of the breakdown of a pulping station, or other special circumstances, coffee may be processed in another pulping station with the written consent of the Board.

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 120

THE POLICE ORDINANCE

(Cap. 84)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 65 of the Police Ordinance the Governor hereby makes the following Regulations:—

THE POLICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1963

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Regulations, 1963.

2. Regulation 35 of the Police Regulations is amended as follows—

- (a) by deleting the words "pay and" appearing in sub-regulation (1) thereof;
- (b) by deleting subparagraph (b) of sub-regulation (2) thereof.
