## THE CONSTITUTION OF KENYA (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1965

(No. 14 of 1965)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Constitution of Kenya (Amendment) Act, 1965, the President hereby makes the following Order:—

## THE CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT OF LAWS) (PUBLIC ORDER) ORDER, 1965

1. This Order may be cited as the Constitution (Amendment of Laws) (Public Order) Order, 1965. Cap. 56.

2. The provisions of the Public Order Act specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order are amended in the manner respectively specified in the second column of the said Schedule. Cap. 56.  
(Sub. Leg.)

3. The Public Order (Licences for Meetings or Processions) Regulations are amended—

(a) by substituting for “licensing officer” wherever it appears the words “District Commissioner” in each case; and

(b) by inserting immediately after the words “police officer” which appear in item 5 of the Schedule thereto the words “or administrative officer”.

## SCHEDULE

<i>Provision</i>	<i>Amendment</i>
s. 2	Delete the definition of “licensing officer” and substitute for the definition of “Minister” the following new definition—  “Minister” means the Minister for the time being responsible for the administration;
s. 5 (3) and (4)	Substitute for “licensing officer” wherever it appears the words “District Commissioner” in each case.
s. 5 (5)	Insert immediately after “police officer” the words “or administrative officer”.
s. 5 (6)	Insert immediately before “police officer” the words “administrative officer or”.

<i>Provision</i>	<i>Amendment</i>
s. 5 (7) (a)	Insert immediately before "police officer" the words "an administrative officer or".
s. 5 (7) (c)	Insert immediately before "police officer" the words "administrative officer or".
s. 5	Substitute for subsection (8) the following new subsection—  (8) Any administrative officer or police officer shall, in and in relation to the performance of any duty or the exercise of any power under the foregoing provisions of this section, comply with such general or specific directions in that behalf as may at any time and from time to time be given by or with the authority of the President, the Minister, the Commissioner of Police or the Provincial Commissioner of the Province concerned.
s. 5 (10) (c)	Insert immediately before "police officer" the words "an administrative officer or".
s. 7 (1) and (6)	Substitute for "Inspector-General of Police or Regional Commissioner of Police as the case may be" wherever it appears the words "Commissioner of Police" in each case.
s. 8 (1)	Substitute for "Inspector-General of Police or a Regional Commissioner of Police" the words "Commissioner of Police or a Provincial Commissioner", and substitute for "Regional Commissioner of Police within his Region" the words "Provincial Commissioner within his Province".
s. 9 (3)	Insert immediately after "the same authority" the words "or by the Commissioner of Police".
s. 9	Insert in its proper numerical order the following new subsection (4)—  (4) Every curfew restriction order shall, forthwith on its being made, be reported to the Commissioner of Police, and the Commissioner of Police may, if he thinks fit, vary or rescind the curfew restriction order.
All sections	Substitute for "Region" wherever it appears the word "Province".
