

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 157

THE KENYA INDEPENDENCE ORDER IN COUNCIL 1963

(L.N. 718 of 1963)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 4 (4) of the Kenya Independence Order in Council 1963, the Governor-General hereby makes the following Order:—

THE KENYA INDEPENDENCE (AMENDMENT OF LAWS)
(WIDOWS' AND ORPHANS' PENSIONS) ORDER, 1964

1. This Order may be cited as the Kenya Independence (Amendment of Laws) (Widows' and Orphans' Pensions) Order, 1964, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 12th December 1963.

2. The provisions of the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order are amended in the manner specified in the second column of that Schedule.

3. The principal Act as amended by paragraph 2 of this Order is amended by substituting for the expression "Governor" wherever it appears therein, in each case, the expression "Governor-General".
