

LEGAL NOTICE No. 166

THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 405)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport and Communications makes the following Rules:—

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1990

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Rules, 1990.

2. The Traffic Rules are amended—

Sub. Leg.

(a) in rule 63, by inserting the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph (e)—

(f) shall not operate any musical instrument in such a manner as to be a nuisance to the passengers or other road users.

(b) by revoking rule 69 and inserting the following new rule—

69. Any person who contravenes or otherwise fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Part shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand shillings or, in default of payment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months.

THE TRAFFIC (DRIVING SCHOOLS) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1990

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Driving Schools) (Amendment) Rules, 1990.

2. Rule 16 (4) of the Traffic (Driving Schools) Rules is amended by inserting the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph (b)—

Sub. Leg.

(c) a current policy of insurance covering the driving test examiner.
