

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 209

THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Traffic Act, the Minister for Power and Communications hereby makes the following Rules:—

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) (No. 3) RULES, 1971

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) (No. 3) Rules, 1971.

2. Rule 7 of the Traffic Rules is hereby amended by the addition of the following new paragraph—

(4) Where a vehicle is registered in Tanzania or in Uganda in addition to being registered under the Act, nothing in this rule shall be construed so as to prohibit the simultaneous exhibition of identification plates carried pursuant to the law of Tanzania or Uganda, as the case may be, together with plates carried pursuant to section 12 of the Act.

3. Paragraph (1) of rule 9 of the Traffic Rules is hereby amended by the deletion of sub-paragraph (c).

4. Rule 94 of the Traffic Rules is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (2) and the substitution therefor of the following—

(2) A motor vehicle in respect of which a valid international certificate is in force shall not be required to be licensed under the Act while in use in Kenya during the currency of such certificate for a period or periods not exceeding in the aggregate—

(a) in the case of a public service vehicle or commercial vehicle, 30 days; and

(b) in the case of any other vehicle, 90 days.

5. The Traffic Rules are hereby amended by the deletion of rule 98 and the Twelfth Schedule.
