

LEGAL NOTICE No. 270

THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Traffic Act, the Minister for Public Works makes the following Rules:—

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) RULES, 1991

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules, 1991.

Sub. Leg.

2. Rule 41 of the Traffic Rules is amended—

(a) in paragraph (1), by inserting the following new subparagraph immediately after subparagraph (a)—

(b) The volumes of liquid products not specified in the Thirteenth Schedule which may be loaded into each category of bulk liquid tank shall not exceed the axle load limits set out in this rule.

(b) in paragraph (5)—

(i) by deleting the words “affixed on” appearing in subparagraph (a) and substituting therefor the words “depicted on or affixed to”;

(ii) by deleting the word “paragraph” appearing in subparagraph (a) (ii) and inserting the word “subparagraph”;

(iii) by substituting the semi-colon at the end of subparagraph (a) (ii) with a colon and inserting the following new proviso:

Provided that vehicles transporting liquids in bulk which are not specified in the Thirteenth Schedule shall only bear the pictorial illustration specified in subparagraph (i).

(iv) by deleting subparagraph (e) and inserting the following new subparagraph—

(e) The signs or legends under subparagraph (a) shall consist of black characters on a white background, and shall be located on each side of the tank mid-way between the top and the base of the tank at the point nearest to the end of the tank which is closest to the front

of the vehicle or trailer and the means of providing the sign or legend shall be at the discretion of the owner of the vehicle or trailer:

Provided that such means shall ensure the durability and legibility of the sign or legend under the conditions prevailing during transport operations.
