THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 118A (2) of the Traffic Act, the City Council of Nairobi hereby makes the following By-laws:—

THE CITY OF NAIROBI (CONTROL OF HAMALI CARTS AND HANDCARTS IN PUBLIC STREETS) BY-LAWS 1966

1. These By-laws may be cited as the City of Nairobi (Control of Hamali Carts and Handcarts in Public Streets) By-laws 1966.

2. In these By-laws—

“City” means the City of Nairobi;

“Council” means the City Council of Nairobi;

“hamali cart” means a four-wheeled cart for the carriage of goods propelled by human energy;

“handcart” means a two- or three-wheeled cart for the carriage of goods propelled by human energy.

3. If the Council are satisfied it is expedient for facilitating the passage of traffic it may from time to time make an Order as regards any public street in the City prohibiting the use of the street by hamali carts or handcarts either generally or subject to exceptions specified in the Order and either at all times or at times, on days or during periods so specified.

4. Every such Order shall be published in the Gazette and a person who uses an hamali cart or a handcart or causes or permits an hamali cart or a handcart to be used in contravention of a prohibition imposed by an Order made by the Council shall be guilty of an offence against these By-laws and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both such fine and period of imprisonment.
