

LEGAL NOTICE No. 309

THE FORESTS ACT

*(Cap. 385)*MOUNT KENYA FOREST—ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES
(WARAZO SETTLEMENT SCHEME)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 4 (1) of the Forests Act, the Minister for Natural Resources hereby declares that the boundaries of the Mount Kenya Forest shall be altered so as to exclude the area described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

An area of land approximately 2,340 acres, situated within and adjoining the south-western boundary of Mount Kenya Forest in Nyeri District, Central Province, the boundaries of which are more particularly delineated, edged red on Boundary Plan No. 175/135 which is signed, sealed with the seal of the Survey of Kenya and deposited in the Survey Records Office, Survey of Kenya, Nairobi, a copy of which may be inspected at the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Forest Department, Nyeri.

DECLARATION OF PRISONS

Cap. 2.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Prisons Act and in pursuance of a delegation* made under section 38 (1) of the Interpretation and General Provisions Act, the Permanent Secretary, Vice-President's Office and Ministry of Home Affairs, hereby declares the area situated near the existing Uruku Tea Nursery in the Meru District, Eastern Province, approximately eleven miles from the existing Meru Prison† towards Nkubu on the existing New Tea Road, having the existing Uruku Forest Reserve on its western side, the Kemitu Forest Reserve on its eastern side, the Kakongwe River on its northern side and bordering with Thingithu River on its southern side, comprising of fifty-nine acres boundaries of which are marked off by a live hedge of "Maigoya" plants and the actual prison buildings of which are fenced, to be a prison for the purposes of the Act.
