THE KENYA INDEPENDENCE ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1963 (L.N. 718 of 1963)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 4 (4) of the Kenya Independence Order in Council, 1963, the Governor-General hereby makes the following Order:—

THE KENYA (AMENDMENT OF LAWS) (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) (No. 6) ORDER, 1964

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Kenya (Amendment of Laws) (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 6) Order, 1964, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 12th December 1963.
- 2. The several written laws specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order are amended, in relation to the provisions thereof specified in the second column, in the manner respectively specified in the third column of the Schedule.

- (a) the Chief Scout;
- (b) the Commissioner;
- (c) not more than fifty members, to be known as elected members, initially appointed by the Governor-General, and thereafter to be elected in accordance with the constitution; and
- (d) such other members as may be provided for by the constitution.
- (2) All rights, assets, liabilities and authorities of the Kenya Branch of the Boy Scouts Association are hereby transferred to and vested in the Council to hold for and on behalf of the Kenya Boy Scouts Association, and the Kenya Branch of the Boy Scouts Association is hereby dissolved.

Functions of Council

- 2C. The Council shall, in addition to any other powers conferred on it, have power to-
- (a) adopt a constitution for the Association and to regulate its relation with other members of the Boy Scouts World Conference;

- (b) do such other things consistent with this Act as are, in its opinion, necessary for the continued wellbeing of the Boy Scout movement in Kenya.

(b) Unqualified Teachers

With effect from 1st April 1964, unqualified teachers serving in any of the urban areas listed below will be eligible for an allowance to bring their total basic monthly emoluments up to the amounts shown in the second column.

2. Responsibility Allowances:

Responsibility allowances will be payable to Principals/Headmasters of all primary schools, secondary schools, trade and technical schools and Training Colleges where such allowances are not payable at present at the rates listed below up to a maximum of £200 p.a.

A. Primary Schools:

- (i) Allowance of £3 per year for each full-time teaching post in the establishment excluding the Headmaster.
- (ii) Where the school is a boarding school the head teacher will receive a further amount of £24 a year in respect of the first 60 boarders or a fraction thereof, the amount rising at the rate of £8 in respect of each additional 30 boarders.
- B. Secondary Schools: (Except in schools with Senior Education Officer posts)
 - (i) Allowance of £6 per year for each full-time teaching post in the establishment excluding the Headmaster.
 - (ii) Allowance of £18 per year for every class of Form IV level and beyond.
 - (iii) Where the school is a boarding school, the Headmaster will receive a further £36 a year in respect of the first 60 boarders or a fraction thereof, rising at the rate of £9 for each additional 30 boarders.

C. Trade and Technical Schools:

Allowances will be as in sections (i) and (iii) in para. B. above.

- D. Training Colleges: (Except in colleges with Senior Education Officer posts).
 - (i) Allowance of £120 per year for a college with less than 120 students.
 - (ii) Allowance of £180 per year for a college with a 120 students or more.

- (ii) Allowances will be payable monthly in arrears on the production of receipted bills.
- (iii) Decisions on whether quarters occupied by teachers are equivalent to Government quarters for the purpose of assessment of allowances and whether such quarters are not out of proportion to the status of the teachers will be determined conclusively by the Education Officers in charge of the urban areas who should seek the technical opinion of the Ministry of Works officers in charge of the urban areas. Such opinion of the officers from the Ministry of Works should be given in writing.
