(Cap. 90)

THE PRISONS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1991

1. These Rules may be cited as the Prisons (Amendment) Rules, 1991.

2. The Prisons Rules are amended—

(a) by deleting rule 114 (1) and inserting the following—

(1) Where a person who is ordered to perform public work under section 68 (G) of the Act is taken to

LEGAL NOTICE No. 372

THE HOTELS AND RESTAURANTS ACT

(Cap. 494)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Hotels and Restaurants Act, the Minister for Tourism and Wildlife makes the following Regulations:—

THE HOTELS AND RESTAURANTS (CLASSIFICATION OF
HOTELS AND RESTAURANTS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1991

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hotels and Restaurants (Classification of Hotels and Restaurants) (Amendment) Regulations, 1991.

Sub. Leg.

2. Regulation 2 is amended by deleting paragraph (4) and inserting the following—

(4) The holder of a hotel licence shall, in respect of a hotel for which he is the licensee, apply in writing to the Authority—

(a) for the hotel to be classified;

(b) for a change in the classification of the hotel, and every application shall be accompanied by a fee of three thousand shillings in respect of each establishment.
