## THE KENYA ORDER IN COUNCIL 1963

(L.N. 245 of 1963)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Kenya Order in Council 1963, and of all other powers thereunto enabling him, the Governor hereby makes the following Regulations:—

THE KENYA (AMENDMENT OF LAWS) (PUBLIC ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1963

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Kenya (Amendment of Laws) (Public Order) Regulations, 1963, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st June 1963.

2. In these Regulations "Ordinance" means the Public Order Ordinance.
