

2. The Kenya National Union of Teachers (hereinafter referred to as the "Union") is authorized to collect subscriptions (other than trade union dues) from its members who belong to the Kipsigis Branch for the approved purpose of financing the construction of a building to be used by the Union in Kericho Township.

3. Every employer who employs at least ten members of the Kipsigis Branch of the Union and upon whom a notice in writing shall have been served by the General Secretary of the Union pursuant to regulation 6 of the Trade Disputes (Levies and Subscriptions other than Trade Union Dues) Regulations is required to deduct from the wages of each of his employees who is named in that notice and who is, and who in the notice acknowledges that he is, a member of the Kipsigis Branch of the Union, the monthly sum of fifty shillings for a period of forty-eight consecutive months and to make payment of the total sum so collected into the Union's account with Barclays Bank of Kenya Limited, Kericho Branch, P.O. Box 79, Kericho.

LEGAL NOTICE No. 40

THE TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 403)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport and Communications makes the following rules:—

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1981

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Rules 1981.

2. Rule 11 (1) of the Traffic Rules is amended by deleting subparagraph (a) and substituting the following—

(a) a valid driving licence or driving permit issued in Uganda, Tanzania or Ethiopia;
