

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 415

THE POLICE ORDINANCE

(Cap. 84)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by Section 65 of the Police Ordinance, the Prime Minister hereby makes the following Regulations—

THE POLICE (POLICE COUNCIL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1963

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Police Council) (Amendment) Regulations, 1963.

L.N. 182/63.

2. Regulation 3 (1) of the Police (Police Council) Regulations, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations), is amended—

(a) by substituting for subparagraph (a) (ii) thereof, a new subparagraph as follows—

(ii) the Director of Personnel, or a person deputed by him;

(b) by inserting at the end of subparagraph (a) (iii) thereof, a new subparagraph as follows—

(iv) one person to be appointed by the Minister.

3. Regulation 5 (2) of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting for the words "or the vice-chairman whenever he considers it necessary", which appear therein, the words "and the vice-chairman whenever they consider it necessary".
