THE TRADE MARKS ORDINANCE, 1955

(No. 51 of 1955)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 41 of the Trade Marks Ordinance, 1955, the Minister for Legal Affairs hereby makes the following Rules:—

THE TRADE MARKS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1959

1. These Rules may be cited as the Trade Marks (Amendment) Rules, 1959.

2. The Trade Marks Rules, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules) are amended by substituting for the words "one month", where they appear in rules 48, 49 and 50 thereof, the words "forty-two days". L.N. 575/56.

3. Rule 51 of the principal Rules is amended by substituting for the words "fourteen days" the words "one month".

4. Paragraph (1) of rule 60 of the principal Rules is amended by substituting for the words "one month", which appear in the first sentence thereof, the words "sixty days".

5. There shall be substituted, for item 30 of Schedule I to the principal Rules, the following item—

30. For advertisement in the Gazette of a trade mark application or matter:		
Covering a quarter column or less of the Gazette	20	—
