THE TRADERS' LICENSING ORDINANCE, 1951

(No. 1) of 1951)

EXEMPTION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 26 of the Traders' Licensing Ordinance, 1951, the Minister for Commerce, Industry and Communications hereby exempts every person who carries on the trade of dealing in hides and skins and who is the holder of a valid buyer's licence in respect of each premises owned or occupied by him for or in connexion with the purposes of that trade, issued in accordance with the provisions of the Hide and Skin Trade Ordinance, from the operation of the Traders' Licensing Ordinance, 1951, in respect of that trade. Cap. 209.
