IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Accountant General (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 1955, the Minister for Finance and Development hereby makes the following Order:—

THE ACCOUNTANT GENERAL (TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS)  
(VARIATION) ORDER, 1961

1. This Order may be cited as the Accountant General (Transfer of Functions) (Variation) Order, 1961.

2. The Accountant General (Transfer of Functions) (No. 5) Order, 1956 (as amended by the Accountant General (Transfer of Functions) Order, 1961), is hereby varied by substitution for paragraph 2 thereof a new paragraph as follows:—

2. The functions vested in the Permanent Secretary to the Treasury by virtue of section 2 of the aforementioned Ordinance and specified in the Schedule to this Order are transferred to the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry for the time being responsible for industry.

THE ACCOUNTANT GENERAL (TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS)  
(No. 3) ORDER, 1961

1. This Order may be cited as the Accountant General (Transfer of Functions) (No. 3) Order, 1961.

2. The functions vested in the Permanent Secretary to the Treasury under section 373 of the Penal Code to receive, and to cut, deface, or destroy with or without compensation, any coin if in his opinion it is counterfeit, is hereby transferred to the Currency Officer of the East African Currency Board.
