## An Act of Parliament to amend the Traffic Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Short title. Act, 1984.

2. Section 2 of the Traffic Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended—

(a) by inserting the following in proper alphabetical sequence—

"matatu" means a public service vehicle having a seating accommodation for not more than twenty-five passengers exclusive of the driver; but does not include a motor car;

(b) by deleting the definition of "motor omnibus" and substituting the following—

"motor omnibus" means a public service vehicle having seating accommodation for more than twenty-five passengers exclusive of the driver.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following new paragraph—

(j) matatus.

4. Section 33 (1) (c) of the principal Act is amended by inserting "matatus and" immediately before "motor omnibuses".

5. Section 96 of the principal Act is amended by adding the following new paragraph—

(h) which is intended to be used as a matatu unless the vehicle has been inspected by an authorized officer appointed under subsection 3 of section 3 of this Act and has complied with the provisions of this Act with regard to construction, equipment and use. Amendment of section 4 of Cap. 403
