

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1990

An Act of Parliament to amend the Public Health Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Health (Amendment) Act, 1990.

Short title.

2. The Public Health Act is amended by inserting the following new sections immediately after section 7—

Insertion of new sections 7A and 7B in Cap. 242.

Committees. 7A. The board may appoint committees, whether of its own members or otherwise, to carry out general or specific functions as may be specified by the board and may delegate to any such committee such of its powers as the board may deem appropriate.

Establishment of district health management boards. 7B. (1) There shall be established a district health management board in each district which shall be charged with responsibility of overseeing the running of Government health institutions in that district.

(2) The Minister may make rules as to the composition of the district health management boards, the convening and holding of meetings of the boards, the procedure thereat, allowances payable to members thereof and the circumstances in which any member shall vacate his membership.
