THE PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1964

An Act of Parliament to amend the Public Holidays Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment) Act, 1964, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st October 1964.

Short title.

2. The Public Holidays Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, is amended by substituting for section 2 thereof the following section—

Amendment of section 2 of Cap. 110.

- 2. (1) The days specified in Part I of the Schedule to this Act shall in every year be kept as public holidays by all public offices and all banks.
- (2) The days specified in Part II of the Schedule to this Act shall, in addition to the days specified in Part I thereof, in every year be public holidays for all persons belonging to the Islamic faith and employed in any public office or bank.
- 3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words "Regional Assembly" which appear therein, the word "Region".

Amendment of section 5 of the principal Act.

4. The principal Act is amended by substituting for the Schedule thereto the following Schedule—
