

**THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION)  
ACT 1968**

**No. 64 of 1968**

*Date of Assent: 27th December 1968*

*Date of Commencement: 30th December 1968*

**An Act of Parliament to fix the salaries and allowances of persons holding certain offices provided for in the Constitution**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Remuneration) Act 1968.

Short title.

**2.** The salaries and allowances to be paid to the holders of the several offices specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Act, being the offices of those descriptions mentioned in section 126 of the Constitution, shall, with effect from the respective dates specified in the second column of that Schedule, be at the annual rates specified in relation to those offices in the third column of that Schedule.

Salaries for certain offices under Constitution.

**3.** The allowances to be paid to appointed members of the Electoral Commission shall be—

Allowances for appointed members of Electoral Commission.

- (a) an attendance allowance of eighty shillings for each day or part of a day on which the Electoral Commission meets and the member is present at the meeting, but so that he shall not be paid more than once in respect of any one day;
- (b) a subsistence allowance at the rates and in the circumstances (in relation to meetings of the Electoral Commission) applicable to the subsistence allowance payable to Members of the National Assembly;
- (c) a transport allowance in respect of any journey made to attend a meeting of the Electoral Commission, at the appropriate rate for the time being in force in respect of Government officers, or, if there is no such rate which is appropriate, at such rate as the Treasury may authorize.

4. (1) Section 2 of the Exchequer and Audit Act is amended by substituting for the definition of "Controller and Auditor-General", which appears therein, a new definition as follows—

"Controller and Auditor-General" means the person appointed as such under section 128 of the Constitution;

(2) Section 7 of the Exchequer and Audit Act is repealed.
